Ensure Your Safety

Move to a safe area away from traffic, and if your vehicle is drivable, pull it to the side of the road to prevent further accidents.



Call 9-1-1

Always report the accident to authorities and request medical assistance if needed, and make sure to obtain a copy of the police report.



Avoid Admitting Fault

Do not admit fault or discuss injuries with the other driver, but ensure you report any injuries, even minor ones, to the police.



Gather Witness Information

Ask witnesses for their contact details to support your case and don't hesitate to request help from bystanders.



Exchange Insurance Information

Share insurance and personal information with the other driver, and let the police coordinate this if they are on the scene.



Document the Scene

Take photos or videos of the accident, vehicle damage, and road conditions if it is safe to do so.



Seek Medical Attention

Visit the ER or your doctor immediately after the accident, even for minor injuries, and follow through with any recommended treatment plans.



Communicate Strategically

Avoid speaking with the other party's insurance company or giving recorded statements, and share all relevant documents with your attorney.



Be Mindful of Social Media

Set your accounts to private, avoid posting about the accident or your activities, and inform your attorney about any existing posts.



Partner With Your Attorney
